INVITATION TO PROSPECTIVE ASSIGNEES IN TERMS OF SECTION 4 OF THE MEAT SAFETY ACT, 2000

The Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries in terms of section 4(1) of the Meat Safety Act, 2000 (Act No. 40 of 2000), is empowered to assign the application of the Act or certain provisions thereof throughout the Republic or in a particular area, to any person with an interest in or particular knowledge of meat and meat safety

Accordingly, prospective assignees that qualify and are competent to provide a meat inspection service under the meat inspection scheme established in terms of section 12 of the Meat Safety Act, 2000 are hereby invited to express interest by making applications to be assigned by the Minister. In order to evaluate the suitability and competence of the prospective assignees, the minimum requirements set out in meat inspection scheme should be taken into consideration when an application form accompanied by supporting documents are submitted to the Provincial Executive Officer (PEO).

The prospective assignees will be selected in accordance with their compliance with the requirements set out in the meat inspection scheme.

Submission of applications

Applications must be submitted in writing to the PEO in the province in which the prospective assignee wishes to operate. Contact details of the PEOs are provided in Part E of the application form.

All prospective assignees are invited to attend an information session to familiarize themselves with the minimum requirements set assignees and the detailed information which should accompany the written application.
